

WHAT TO DO AFTER A CRAIGSLIST SCAM


If you find yourself the victim of this scam, the Association of REALTORS® recommends the following:

- Save all email communications, including a copy of the original Craigslist ad (screenshot is best)
- · Contact the rental company and agent if listed in the ad
- Report the ad to Craigslist by clicking the "Flag" link within the ad itself (see screenshot)
- Contact the Dare County Sheriff's Department to report the incident:


