




The Northwest Railway Museum has all the bells and whistles!



Washington State changed forever when the Northern Pacific Railroad reached Tacoma in 1883. In a few short years, the rails led nearly everywhere, and the Snoqualmie Valley was no exception. The Northwest Railway Museum tells this story of settlement and development in the Snoqualmie Depot, aboard the train, and on the Museum campus on Stone Quarry Road. Climb aboard for both adventure and enlightenment.

Incorporating more than five miles of Victorian-era railway and the 1890-built Snoqualmie Depot, the Museum is like no other: antique trains operate weekends from April 'til October and operate to transport visitors not to another place, but to another time. The exhibit galleries are open daily in the summer, and with reduced hours in the spring and fall. Yet no matter when you visit, there are a multitude of "train"ing opportunities!

Fall City is a family friendly, scenic Snoqualmie Valley unincorporated community located approximately 26 miles east of Seattle nestled along the banks of the Snoqualmie and Raging Rivers.

The rivers, trails and surrounding farms play a major role in drawing visitors to this area. In the summer and fall, fishing, river floating or playing along the broad beautiful, gently sloping shoreline offer residents and visitors lots of recreational opportunities. Fall City also offers year-round access to the Preston-Fall City and Snoqualmie Valley trails for hikers, bikers and horseback riders. Valley farms and roadside stands supply fresh flowers and vegetables.



Fall City is a perfect day trip any time of year. Start your morning at Aroma Coffee, Fall City's newest gathering place and community hub. Located inside a historic farmhouse at the edge of town, this quaint café's coffee is as delightful as the conversations happening

within it. From there, take a self-guided walking tour, browse the many antique and consignment shops, dine at any one of the locally owned restaurants or pick up local produce and picnic favorites from the farm fresh market for lunch or dinner in the park or along the riverbank.


As you stroll through town, keep an eye out for historical plaques, brochures for your self-guided tour and pop-up displays. The Fall City Historical Society preserves the rich history of this small town by sharing the stories from past generations throughout the community.

The Fall City Metropolitan Park District and King County Parks are continually improving recreational opportunities in Fall City. Known for its trails, camping and river float trips, Fall City is one of Western Washington's best kept secrets.

If old growth forests and one of a kind overnight experiences sound enticing, it's time to go "To The Trees!", as Treehouse Masters and Tree House Point founder Pete Nelson loves to say. Spend the night in one of several masterfully designed and crafted tree houses. Enjoy a warm evening by the bon fire and a farm to table country breakfast served on the grounds with the birds, squirrels and local wildlife keeping you company.

The colors of autumn come alive early October and so do the local farms that call Fall City home. Pumpkin patches and fall produce are abundant along Hwy 203. Both Fall City Farms and Remlinger Farms, just down the road in Carnation, are known by locals as places to visit for fall family fun.

Immerse yourself in history and culture at the North Bend Historical Museum and the North Bend Railway Museum or explore the expansive trails and the picturesque Rattlesnake Lake. North Bend offers a wide array of year-round recreation, including hiking, fishing, mountain biking, climbing, kayaking, swimming and wildlife observation. During the winter months, snowboarding, skiing and snowshoeing are just minutes away.

North Bend also boasts a 35,000 square feet bike park open to all levels of riders at Torguson Park. For scooter and skateboard thrill seekers, the new skate park at Torquson Park is the largest in the region offering a variety of rails and ramps.

Year-round recreation is easy at Si View Community Center which offers fitness classes, camps and swim lessons for all ages. The park and fields on the campus hosts a variety of sports, summer Farmer's Market and outdoor activities.

North Bend is a fascinating community that brings together a blend of historic small-town charm and a contemporary hipster vibe.



Many of the buildings and shops have called North Bend home for generations including the historic North Bend Theater. Having just celebrated its 80th anniversary, this one screen movie theater is everything you would love from an early 1900's motion picture house including its original velvet red chairs. 

With first-run movies, film festivals, live concerts, and stand up comedy, they continue to be the local choice for entertainment, arts, and culture.




Si View Community Center







Elk Viewing in the wild! Don't forget to bring your camera!

- Always observe from a distance, preferably downwind.
- Use binoculars or spotting scopes.
- Talk and move quietly; minimize sharp sounds.
- Early morning and twilight are ideal times to see animals; also check nearby fields for herds.
- Do not disturb animals in mating season, particularly bull elk in the fall rutting season.
- Never come between a mother and her offspring.
- If an animal becomes nervous or moves away, you are too close.
- Pets should stay home.
- For Safety, park at Centennial Field.





In the Snoqualmie Valley!

Bring a camera! You can watch the upper Snoqualmie Valley's wild elk enjoy the open fields of Meadowbrook Farm Park from your car, or a paved, ADA accessible walking trail! This historic public open space is at the center of the 500-member elk herd's home range and offers multiple walking trails and car pull-outs for wildlife viewing.

While the elk may shelter in the trees during heavy rains, mornings and late afternoon or evenings are the best times to look for them, especially during summer and fall. Don't see an elk right away? Drive slowly around the perimeter of the Park-the elk may be in a nearby field. Walk quietly into one of the hidden fields. Visit the Snoqualmie Falls, sample the Valley's dining, breweries and shops, and look again for elk a bit later. Enjoy your visit to this unique public park!

TOP DOG PARKS & TRAILS IN THE VALLEY



Three Forks Off-Leash Dog Park

Adjacent to the natural area is the Three Forks Off-Leash Dog Park, consisting of eight acres of mowed open space for large and small dogs.

Snoqualmie Falls

The short trail to the base of Snoqualmie Falls during high water levels is really more of an experience than a true hike. Dogs on leash are welcome.

The trail is a tourist stroll on a nice day, but the falls often are at their most dramatic during bad weather.

Snoqualmie Falls is the most famous waterfall in our state. It is 268 feet high with the width ranging from 50 to 150 feet, depending on water levels.

Meadow Loop Trail at Meadowbrook Farms

Beginning at the Meadowbrook Farm Interpretive Center and traversing much of Meadowbrook Farm, this trail is initially gravel, then grassy, and returns to the Interpretive Center via the paved trail along Park Street and Boalch Avenue. Park at the Interpretive Center, and enjoy the views of Mount Si!

Round trip approximately 2.25 miles; good all year, but boots advised in winter!

Fall City Community Park

This park has a baseball field, horse arena, open space and lots of river access.

The Snoqualmie Tribe has implemented a large habitat restoration project in this King County Park, which began in 2009. In total, 14.2 acres have been restored, including an interpretive trail through the park, and 14,178 native plants planted.

Little Si Trailhead

This popular hike is perfect for your four legged friends.

The small rocky bluff known as Little Si is the neighbor and little brother Mount. Si.

Little Si is a moderately graded 3.7 mile trail located in the hike rich North Bend area. The trail's proximity to the city and a degree of refuge from the elements often divert heavy foot traffic to this mini-mountain, keeping it busy year round.

Snoqualmie is best known for Snoqualmie Falls, a breathtaking waterfall cascading 268 feet over granite cliffs. As one of Washington's most popular scenic attractions, the Snoqualmie Falls brings over 2 million tourists to the area annually.

Not all those visitors are making their way to the Falls to take in the glorious views and park, some are coming to get a glimpse of famous attractions from 90s cult classic show Twin Peaks. Salish Lodge and Spa is one of Washington's premiere destinations and a treat for anyone desiring a luxurious resort experience. With that said, Salish plays the role as The Great Northern Hotel well and offers Twin Peaks fans a selection of show inspired merchandise at The Country Store located inside the Lodge and photo opportunities to satisfy a lifetime of fandom.

Historic downtown Snoqualmie also provides visitors with many opportunities to dine, shop and grab those can't miss photos! Located along the Snoqualmie River, historic downtown has the quintessential small-town vibe, but unlike most towns, this town was built along the railway line and is home to the Historic Snoqualmie Depot built in 1890. The Snoqualmie Depot, now property of the Northwest Railway Museum, is the oldest continuously operating train depot in the state operating from the late 1800's to the 1970's. The Northwest Railway Museum proudly serves to provide guests with the rich history of the railroad and offers rides from downtown to Snoqualmie Falls and North Bend.

Downtown Snoqualmie is the ideal daytrip or afternoon outing with many dining options. If a refreshing brew or glass of wine is on the menu, look no further. Snoqualmie is home to several locally owned breweries and wineries that will satisfy your thirst. Wine drinkers have several wineries and tasting rooms to choose from.

A mile up the Snoqualmie Parkway is Snoqualmie Ridge, a master planned residential community complete with schools, miles of trails, open spaces, parks, athletic fields and a quaint shopping and dining district. Consistently named among Washington's safest communities, both Snoqualmie Ridge and downtown are a perfect place to raise a family.

One of Snoqualmie's newest draws located on Snoqualmie Ridge is Sno-King Ice Arena which offers everything from hockey leagues and figure skating to ice skating lessons and public skate. The Ridge is also home to The Club at Snoqualmie Ridge, a Jack Nicklaus Signature Design Course and host club of the Boeing Classic.

Just one exit up from Hwy18 on I-90E sits Snoqualmie Casino and Crescent Market. 





Drowning Prevention

Drowning is a preventable tragedy and an important public health and safety issue. Warm weather draws people to lakes, rivers and saltwater areas. This creates high risk situations for the individual, others, and rescuers. Swimmers, boaters, and other water recreationists should follow these recommendations to prevent drownings:

- **Know the risks** Rivers are cold and the water moves fast. Waters are often cold enough to cause muscles to cease and cramp, even on the hottest summer day. Cold water can weaken even the strongest swimmer.
- Learn to swim, including water safety and survival skills -To enjoy the water safely, learn swim strokes, water safety, survival skills, and become comfortable in the water.
- Wear a lifejacket Always wear a U.S. Coast Guard approved lifejacket when boating, tubing, paddle boarding, rafting, swimming or when participating in other activities in or on the water.
- Swim where there is a lifeguard Swim in areas with lifequards when possible.
- **Supervise children in or near water** Always provide close and constant attention to children you are supervising in or near water.
- Do not use alcohol or drugs during water activities -Never use alcohol or other impairing drugs during water and boating activities, or while supervising children around the water.
