ECHO serves the Sumter and Myrtle Beach communities breaking the cycles of homelessness experienced by individuals and families. With the increase in the homeless population, this organization has proven to be one of the most effective catalysts for our community. Outside of providing housing, this recipient provides continuous case management and outside resources for those in need. During 2022, this organization served a total of 8,688 persons, 4,295 households, 363 veterans, 206 domestic violence survivors, 34 youth and young adults, 188 chronically homeless, 206 disabled veterans and 672 disabled persons.
