The Chisholm Trail Roundup Bar-B-Que Cook Off will be held on the same weekend as all other CTR events and will be located at the Lockhart City Park (504 E City Park Road) on June 11 & 12, 2021.

Please register prior to the cook-off. All RV's and campers MUST pre-register. The first day of registration begins April 19th, 2021. The last day to register is June 10th, 2021, or until no more spaces are unavailable. Spaces are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis with submitted application and paid entry fee.

This year's cook-off will be sanctioned by Lonestar Barbecue Society. **Please read and follow the Rules & Regulations of the Lonestar Barbecue Society.** There will only be two ways to pay and reserve spots this year so as to avoid double-booking. First, in person at the Lockhart Chamber of Commerce location, 702 S Commerce Street, Lockhart, Texas 78644. And secondly, on-line by visiting www.chisholmtrailroundup.com and completing the online registration.

Cook's meeting will be Saturday, June 12, 2021 at 10:00 A.M. in the judging tent of the Barbecue area. Please review rules and regulations for changes to setup this year.

RULES & REGULATIONS

This event is held by the Lockhart Chamber of Commerce & Chisholm Trail Roundup with all rules for judging as written by that organization and the Lonestar Barbecue Society.

SETUP: ALL Contestants entering the Cook-Off may set up **NO EARLIER than 5 P.M. on the Thursday prior to the cook off** ONLY if entry fee has been paid and registration is complete. If entry fee has not been paid by team, team will not be designated a spot. The Barbecue area will be located in the enclosed softball field located across from the Rodeo parking area. The entrance is accessible only from Carver Street. (See map) NO PARKING WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE INFIELD. Teams can only setup on grass area of softball field.

TEAMS: A team will consist of a Chief Cook and up to three (3) assistants. Chief Cook will be held responsible for the conduct of the team. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages will be grounds for disqualification, with no refund of entry fee(s). **ALL PERSONAL ALCOHOL MUST STAY IN DESIGNATED BARBQUE AREA.** UNDERAGE DRINKING WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AND TEAMS WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE IMMEDIATELY (police enforced if necessary). Quiet time is from 1 A.M. to 8 A.M. Only moderate amplification during the day. Contestants **MUST** be signed in before cooks meeting, Saturday 12th, 2021 at 10:00 A.M.

CONDUCT: If at any given time the chief cook, assistant cooks, team members, or anybody associated with a team, are found to be disrespectful, unsportsmanlike, or any other inappropriate behavior deemed unexceptable by the chairman, that team will be asked to leave immediately (police enforced if necessary), and will not be allowed to return to another CTR cook-off. Our staff and crew members are donating their time and support to ensure that everyone has a great time while being safe. Please keep this in consideration during your stay with us at Chisholm Trail Roundup Barbecue Cook-Off.

MEETING OF COOKS: A mandatory cook's meeting will be held on Saturday, June 12th, 2021 at 10 A.M. under the judging tent located on the barbecue layout map provided.

COOKED ON SITE: Any category entered must be cooked on site, as defined in the Lonestar Barbecue Society By-laws without pre-cooking or marinating. Rules and regulations may change without notice, if alternative site is chosen. No exceptions.

PARKING: There will be a limited amount of available spots to reserve this year. Cooking spots 1-37 are 40X20. Cooking spots 38-39 are 50X30. The 2 larger cooking spots can be purchased with an additional \$25.00 fee separate from team entry fee. If it does not fit, contestants will not be allowed to park in the cook-off area. Each team will only be allowed one vehicle in their designated spot as long as it doesn't exceed spot size. Any other vehicles will be parked in a designated parking lot next to the barbeque area. NO PARKING ALLOWED IN DESIGNATED FIRE LINES!! Each team will be allowed only two (2) free park entries and (2) Barbeque parking permits. All others will be required to pay upon entry into the park. No golf carts or any other wheeled transportation, other than medically necessary, will be allowed in the park for any contestants. All RV's and campers will be parked longways in designated cooking spot unless larger spot is purchased. NO EXCEPTIONS.

SANITATION: Cooks are to prepare and cook in as sanitary a manner as possible. Cooking conditions are subject to inspection by judging committee. Infractions identified by the judging committee shall be immediately corrected or the cook will be subject to disqualification. During and after the event, each team is required to keep the area clean of all trash.

NO OPEN GROUND FIRES ARE PERMITTED!

Pets are to be leashed and kept in Barbeque area. THEY ARE NOT ALLOWED ANYWHERE ELSE DURING CHISHOLM TRAIL ROUNDUP WEEKEND!!

CATEGORIES: Cook-off promoters shall advise contestants in advance of applicable meat categories and/or cut of meats and/or types of cookers.

BEEF BRISKET: Turn in approximately 7 full 1/4" to 3/8" slices

PORK SPARE RIBS: Turn in approximately 7 individual cut ribs (bone-in). St. Louis style is okay.

CHICKEN: Turn in approximately 2 halves of chicken.

* Chicken cannot be disjointed, to include skin, breast, wing, leg, and thigh.

TURN-IN TIMES: Times for each category shall be pre-set. Once the time is set and/or announced, no changes will be made. A turn-in window of ten (10) minutes before and after the set turn-in times will be recognized. Judging trays received after that time will not be accepted for judging.

Chicken: 12 Noon Saturday, June 12, 2021

Pinto Beans: 1:00 P.M. Saturday, June 12, 2021 (separate application required)

Pork Spare Ribs: 1:30 P.M. Saturday, June 12, 2021

Chili: 2:00 P.M. Saturday, June 12, 2021 (separate application required)

Brisket: 3:00 P.M. Saturday, June 12, 2021

Best Pit: 1:00 – 2:00 P.M. Saturday, June 12, 2021

Showmanship (Tolbert) 2:15 – 3:05 P.M. (must cook chili to Show) Saturday, June 12, 2021

RULES & REGULATIONS Continued

JUDGES: A minimum of five (5) judges per table will be utilized during initial judging. Subsequent levels of judging should utilize a minimum of seven (7) or a maximum of nine (9) judges per table. Head cooks are prohibited to participate as judges.

Barbecue and ribs will be judged on aroma, appearance, color, texture, moisture, taste, and overall impression. Judging will be under the direction of Lonestar Barbecue Society. **THE DECISION OF THE JUDGES ARE FINAL.**

ANNOUNCING WINNERS: Announcement of ALL winners will be held at the judging tent in the barbeque area at the end of the day after all judging has been completed. Announcement of each category will be based on turn-in times. The announcements of winners will be based on the number of competitors in each category. Example: Cook off with ten or more entries announces the top 10 plus final table (numbers only). It is recommended that more than one person verify ticket numbers.

PRIZES: A Grand Champion and Reserve Champion will be named at our cook off. In the event of a tie for Grand Champion, brisket will be the first tie breaker, followed by ribs, then chicken, and then by any other category. The promoter MUST advertise any changes to the tie breaker decision in advance.

Grand Champion and Reserve Champion – reserved and paid spot for the following year at CTR.

Brisket: *1st place \$400
*2nd place \$250
*3rd place \$150

Pork Spare Ribs: *1st place \$400
*2nd place \$250
*3rd place \$150

Chicken: *1st place \$400
*2nd place \$250
*3rd place \$150

Best Pit: Trophy

Pay-out is based on entry fee of 40 cooks and can be subject to change

Cash prizes and awards will be given to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places for each category, while 4th-10th places will receive awards.

Chili / Pinto Bean entries require a separate application and entry fee, both of which are included at the end of the BBQ application.

Saturday, June 12, 2021

An entry fee of \$15.00 per item entered for Chili is required with the application (attached). An entry fee of \$10.00 is required for the Pinto Bean Cook-Off.

No more than five (5) Cooks allowed per team, including the Chief Cook. The Chief Cook will be responsible for the conduct of the team. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages will be grounds for disqualification(s).

Contestants must cook a minimum of two pounds of meat (Chili Grind Only).

No limit to amount of other ingredients; however, beans, rice or other fillers cannot be added. All ingredients must be cooked on contest premises. Contestants are encouraged to make samples available for the crowd. No identifiable ingredients such as large chunks of tomato, peppers, etc. shall be included in the Chili cups turned in for judging.

Chili and Pinto Beans will be judged on appearance, aroma, texture and taste.

THE DECISIONS BY THE JUDGES ARE FINAL.

Prizes will be awarded to 1st through 10th places in Chili and 1st through 10th places in Pinto Beans. There will be three (3) Showmanship Trophy awards.

Contestants must clean their area no later than 12 P.M. on Sunday.

Contest committee reserves the right to make additional rules and regulations as the situation warrants.

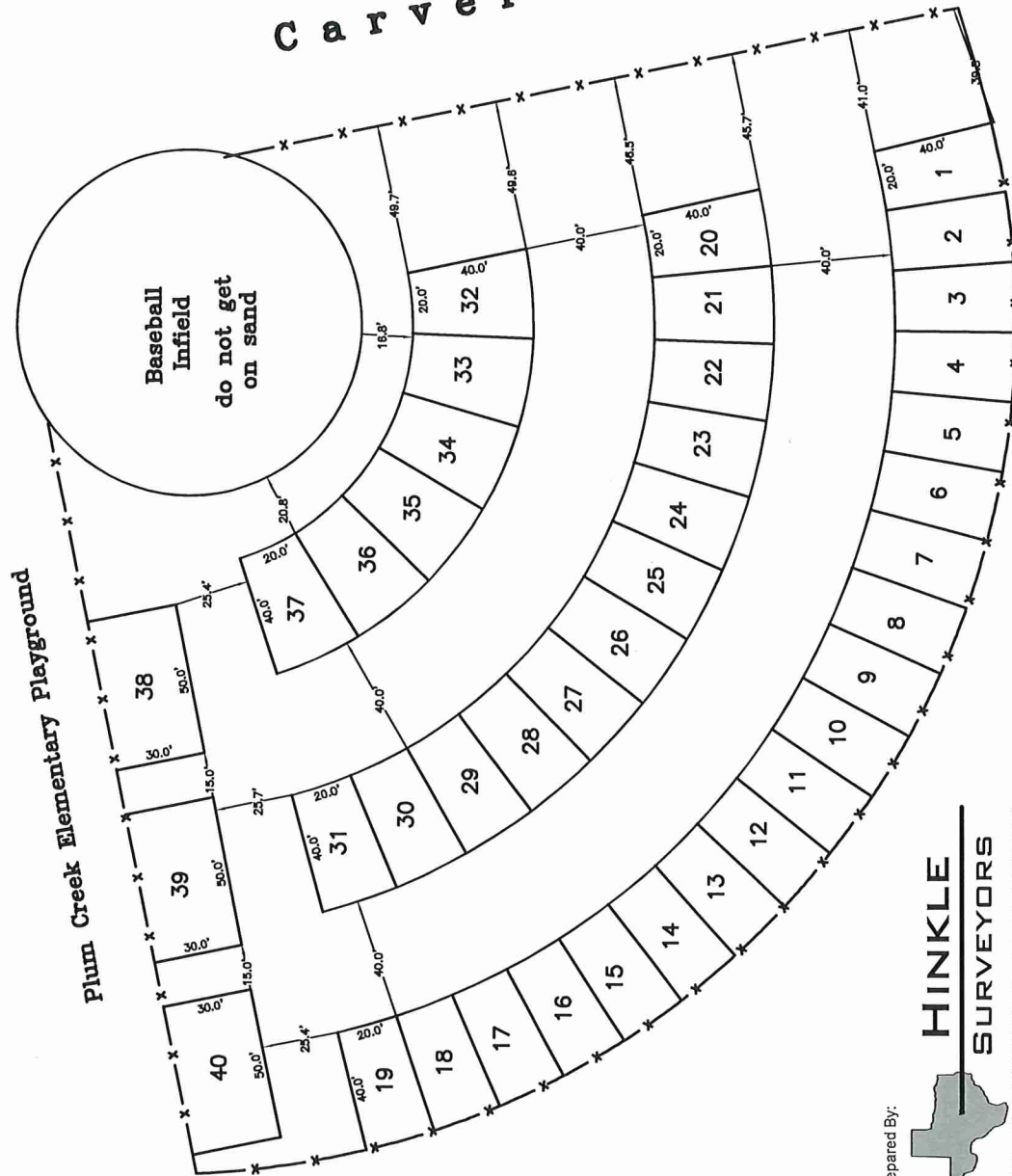


CTR Tolbert Chili & Bean 2021
