OCRA's Community Development Block Grant funding will be available for businesses within New Castle city limits. The primary objective of this funding is to preserve (retain) jobs for low- to-moderate income people.

- Up to \$25,000 grant
- For businesses located within New Castle
- 51% of jobs retained must be held by persons of low to moderate income.
