# **2022 Policy Statements**

# **Early Childhood Care and Education**

Ellevate requests funding of at least \$50 million into the Early Childhood Education Fund for FY2022 as well as the additional \$44 million for early care and education in the FY2023 Executive Budget.

## Statewide Broadband

Ellevate supports the efforts of the Office of Broadband and Development to provide statewide access.

# **Long Term Care**

Ellevate supports requiring improvements to the safety of our long-term care facilities and requesting LDH to study options for delaying institutionalization of frail elders.

### **Behavioral Health**

Ellevate supports funding for crisis stabilization for fiscal year 2023 and requiring the screening of new mothers for perinatal depression and mood disorders.

#### **Telehealth**

Ellevate supports legislation that strengthens and broadens the use of telehealth and telemedicine services

# Women's Health

Ellevate supports the creation of an office of women's health to study and coordinate issues of aging, maternal health, behavioral health, violence and disease prevention.

### **Domestic Violence**

Ellevate opposes legislation that moves Louisiana backwards in terms of victims' rights and protections.

# **Healthcare Workforce Shortage**

Ellevate supports efforts to alleviate shortages of health care professionals through apprenticeships, continuing education, and K-12 career readiness programs.
