

Discover Agate Beach

Explore Yaquina Head Lighthouse & Interpretive Center (#2) Take a tour of the lighthouse, enjoy up close views of seabird nesting areas, and explore the year round tide pools. Beach comb for agates and observe the local surfers at the Agate Beach Wayside which provides beach access as well as a public picnic area and hiking and biking trails.
