Abstract Instructions

English is the official language of the conference. Individuals can serve as an author on multiple abstracts, however, an individual may present no more than two accepted abstracts. Submitting author will be notified of the decision and presentation format (oral or poster) via email by June 30, 2021. All abstracts will be distributed to conference participants and will be freely available in

New this year:

Awards for Best Posters by Trainees

Eligible persons are either in training or within 1 year of finishing training (masters, PhD, post-doctoral, residency, fellowship, etc.) and are first author on the abstract.

There will be 2 awards:

Best Psychometric Poster by a Trainee and Best Application of PROMIS Poster by a Trainee

Directions for Abstract Submission

The word limit for the abstract body is 350 words (excluding title, authors, and affiliations). Your abstract must include this information:

Title: Please use both upper- and lower-case letters in the title (LIMIT is 15 words)

Type of Presentation: Indicate oral, poster, or either presentation.

Authors: List full name of each author.

Institutional Affiliations: List the primary institutional affiliation for each author.

Body: Use separate paragraphs for each section – Objective, Methods, Results, Conclusions.

Do not include figures and tables. Limit is 350 Words.

Presenter: Include name and email address of presenting author. Deadline: Sunday, April 25, 2021, 11:59 pm CT (USA & Canada)
