Abstract Instructions

English is the official language of the conference. Individuals can serve as an author on multiple abstracts, however, an individual may present no more than two accepted abstracts. Submitting author will be notified of the decision and presentation format (oral or poster) via email by June 30, 2021. All abstracts will be distributed to conference participants and will be freely available in pdf format on the conference website. Unless otherwise specified, the first author will be considered as the presenting author. All presenters and attendees must register for the conference.

Directions for Abstract Submission

The word limit for the abstract body is 350 words (excluding title, authors, and affiliations). Your abstract must include this information:

Title: Please use both upper- and lower-case letters in the title (LIMIT is 15 words)

Type of Presentation: Indicate oral, poster, or either presentation.

Authors: List full name of each author.

Institutional Affiliations: List the primary institutional affiliation for each author.

Body: Use separate paragraphs for each section – Objective, Methods, Results, Conclusions.

Do not include figures and tables. Limit is 350 Words.

Presenter: Include name and email address of presenting author.

Deadline: Sunday, April 25, 2021, 11:59 pm CT (USA & Canada)
