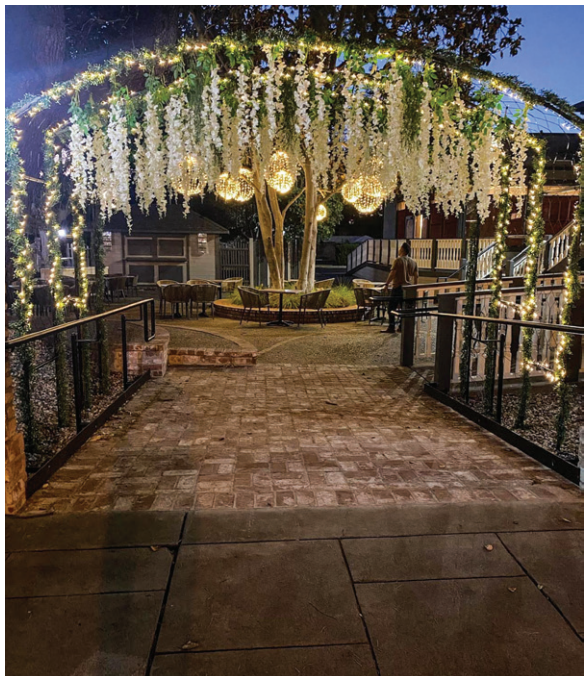




TeaZenTea is coming soon to downtown Pleasanton with authentic boba teas, coffees, smoothies, slushes and more. Located at 624 Main Street.
