It's the terrible experience that you have as a patient in the healthcare system, whether it's the rushed doctor office visit, or the long wait at an emergency room," he said.

Dickinson found the AFC opportunity as a way to design the healthcare service around the patient's preferences and convenience, not the doctor's preference and convenience. "We call it Urgent Care because that is the term that most people recognize, but what we really are is a Retail Medical experience," said Dickinson.

American Family Care Pleasanton has lab services, x-ray machines, EKG, and a procedure room all

onsite. They can diagnose broken bones and sprains, and supply you with any needed braces, splints, immobilizers, boots, and crutches. They test for infectious diseases (flu, COVID-19, strep, RSV, mono). They can also draw blood for all manner of blood tests. Most basic blood tests can be done onsite, but they can also send out comple x tests to a local lab for rapid turnaround results. They provide the most common injection medications, IV fluids, IV medications, nebulizers, and tetanus shots. They also have flu shots and will soon have Pfizer COVID boosters when they become available.


