I. Introductions

- a. Around the Room: 7 people attended and each member introduced their business to the group. We discussed ways that we rest and recharge when we are not working.

II. New Business Overall

- a. Ski Day went well and it was a good opportunity to see a few faces in a safe and socially distanced way.
- b. Wednesday, May 19, 3pm will be our next mixer. In place of our usual call, we will be participating in Breck Cleanup day.
- c. Membership update: The Chamber is promoting business discounts like a 20% discount to Keystone Science School for chamber members only, a discount for the workspace. There is a myriad of discounts available for chamber members, and the chamber would like to educate the members on these discounts.
- d. The Chamber is sending out 1-2 Newsletter each month to feature new jobs or events in the area. Blair says that they would like to make the chamber a go-to place for jobs.
- e. Scholarship was given out to 3 students.

III. New Business - Committee Updates

- a. Still organizing the committees.
- b. Breck Leads Group - moving to the first Tuesday of the month starting in June. Kristylee will be restarting this leads group.
- c. Walkable Main Street - Corey spoke and said they did the surveys and will make a decision at the April 27th meeting whether or not they will do the Walkable Main. They will also discuss the ordinances that were relaxed in 2020 and whether or not those will continue (relating to parking or outdoor signage). That discussion will be May 12th.
- d. Mask mandate for the town of Breck. They are removing signage and will be requiring masks indoors and outdoors where 6 feet is not possible, to make it consistent with the rest of the county.
- e. Restaurant Revitalization stimulus is pending. The SBA will be releasing an opening date soon. Restaurants are waiting on that.
- f. Blair referenced a letter from a group of community leaders addressing the town council's policy of "we need a shoulder season". The letter accuses the town council of being anti-tourism and anti-business.
- g. Resident Expectations Survey have gone out and you should all have them. This will help town council make decisions based on educated decisions.
- h. Town Council will be talking about the policies surrounding STR here in the near future. They are considering limiting STR licenses.
