

Class of 2024 Now Forming!

Since 1991, almost 800 area leaders have graduated from the Monroe County Leadership Monroe program. These graduates represent many area businesses and/or service organizations throughout Monroe County and the Region.

About Leadership Monroe

The Leadership Monroe program is designed to empower, educate, and equip people to serve our community through a dynamic program that is rooted in experiential learning, encouraging self-discovery, and fostering relationships through the monthly sessions. The LM program is a nationally recognized nine-month program created to develop and promote leadership within our community.

Each class size is approximately 20-participants. We begin the journey with an evening orientation on Thursday September 7, 2023, and then the adventure kicks off officially with a camp style retreat. The dates of this retreat are September 14-16, 2023. Participants will leave Monroe on Thursday September 14, 2023, at 5:00 pm and head to Camp Desales in Brooklyn, MI. You can view the retreat center by visiting https://www.desales.org/retreat-center/. You will return on Saturday around 1:30 pm (transportation is provided both ways by bus).

Starting in October the class meets one day a month on the second Tuesday of each month. You can find the calendar on the website at https://www.monroecountychamber.com/leadership-monroe/.

During the monthly classes, we will be exploring the core of our community with sessions focused on economic development, our educational systems, health and human services, key non-profit organizations and visiting various businesses both large and small throughout Monroe County. Leadership principles are built into the curriculum of each monthly session.

What is the cost to participate in the Leadership Monroe program?

The tuition fee is \$1,995 for the class. In many cases, the participant's employer pays for the tuition costs, so applicants may want to inquire if this is an option for them. There is a deposit required of \$500 upon acceptance of your application. The balance is due prior to orientation on September 7, 2023. What are the benefits to the employer?

The program offers real world education in leadership by exposure to key leaders within our community. It reinforces the importance of teamwork and provides an opportunity to help your staff become involved with our community. There will be many networking opportunities with other businesses and organizations, and it shows your support of leadership development in our community by providing your key employees the opportunity to gain experience about the needs/issues in Monroe County. The monthly classes are held locally in Monroe County.

Deadline for applications

Applications are due as soon as possible. The class size is limited to 20 participants, Applications will be reviewed in the first two weeks of August.
