Grant Award: One award of up to \$1,000 will be given to an undergraduate or graduate student submitting the best proposal for wetland related research to be conducted in 2018. The grant will be awarded within 30 days of selection and formal acceptance by the awardee.

Applications must be received no later than April 16th, 2018

Requirements: All research projects must be conducted in New England. Papers based on the funded research must acknowledge the support of SWS-New England. SWS-New England strongly encourages presentation of the results of this research at its Annual Chapter Meeting in the spring of 2019. In lieu of presentation, a report of the research results must be submitted by February 28, 2019. If this research is part of a larger project, partial results are acceptable.

Students must submit their application <u>by email</u> in a single, consolidated document—pdf format—to the contacts listed below. See the attached application form for the required information.

Process/Schedule: The proposals will be reviewed by the Student Awards Committee of SWS-NE for relevance, clarity of hypotheses, suitability of methods, feasibility, and qualifications of the applicant. All applicants will be notified of the decision no later than **May 5th 2018**.
