



Legislative Affairs Update

Roundtable Discussion on Warehouse Development Takes Place in the Inland Empire

On Monday, October 23, 2023, a meeting involving the Inland Empire Warehouse Roundtable was held in San Bernardino, hosted by California State Assemblymember James Ramos (D-45). The roundtable brought together a wide range of stakeholders, including Inland Empire-based local elected officials and representatives of building trades unions, industrial real estate advocates and environmental justice groups to discuss the future of warehouse development in the region.

The establishment of such a roundtable group was precipitated by two competing state legislative bills in 2023 relative to the regulation of warehouses statewide - both bills failed to make it through the State Assembly. These bills were AB 1000 (Reyes, D-50), a *de facto* ban on the development of new warehouses and the expansion of existing ones, and AB 1748 (Ramos) which was a relatively more practical alternative to Asm. Reyes' bill. The latter called for a thousand-foot buffer between logistics centers / warehouses and ill-defined sensitive receptors.

The roundtable discussion, which included four distinct panels, was productive for the commercial real estate industry, with several panelists emphasizing the importance of logistics facilities and warehouses to the viability of Southern California's economy and supply chain.

NAIOP SoCal will continue to monitor and share developments emanating from this roundtable discussion.
