

If you are a traveler who was in another state (other than CT, MA, NJ, PA, or VT) for more than 24 hours before entering New York State, you:

- Must obtain a COVID-19 test within three (3) days of departure from that state.
- Must, upon arrival in New York, quarantine for three (3) days.
- On day four (4) of their quarantine, must obtain another COVID-19 test. If both tests come back negative, travelers may exit quarantine early upon receipt of the second negative diagnostic test.
- Must fill out the <u>Traveler Health Form</u> (scan QR code below with your smartphone camera to fill out form) upon entry into New York state, and take a COVID-19 diagnostic test four (4) days after their arrival in New York. The form can also be filled out by visiting the following website:
