"the ability to set clear, tangible goals and devise a robust route to achieving them."

Why is this skill important?

Showing great aiming high skills is really important as it helps you try your best, look for challenges and set goals to stretch you.

Success criteria:

Did the learner?

- Discuss and record ideas about how to find information about different careers.
- Explore a realistic career goal and the possible routes to this goal.
- Use the following three headings, create lists that will support the development of a career timeline:
 - Things to do
 - Places
 - People
- Discuss and identify options and decisions that will need to be made at different points of their career journey.
- Create a timeline to reach a career destination (e.g. a career, qualification, work experience).
- · Identify a date (e.g. month, year) to reach their career destination.
- · Share their career plan with others.
