

Apprentice of the Year

Open to apprentices of any age, the Apprentice of the Year Award will be given to the individual who has best demonstrated their commitment to learning, a strong work ethic and dedication to achieving their potential in all areas of their apprenticeship framework.

Criteria

- 1. The entrant must have a commitment to learning. They should demonstrate a strong work ethic and dedication to achieving their potential in all areas of their apprenticeship framework and outline their experience and achievements to date (unscored).
- 2. The entrant should demonstrate how they have sought out additional knowledge to enhance their capabilities.
- 3. The entrant should demonstrate how they are a role model for vocational qualifications by proactively being an ambassador for apprenticeships. There should be evidence of their ability to inspire not only other people to become an apprentice, but also employers with a belief in the value of apprenticeship training.
- 4. The entrant should evidence how they have embraced the challenge of a demanding work placement and study programme.
- 5. The entrant should demonstrate a keen understanding of their employer's business strategy and objectives, and their will to contribute to these in a meaningful way.
- 6. The entrant should evidence the attributes that they possess that will enable them to achieve success in their chosen profession.

- All questions are given equal weighting.

- Entrants may provide a maximum of 3 pieces of evidence to support their submission. Evidence must consist of images only i.e. charts/pictures. Entrants may be asked for additional information, including evidence of financial information, at the interview stage (Stage 2).


