Criteria

- 1. The entrant should describe their business in 400 words or less enabling judges to gain an understanding of their company, its history, customers, competitors, challenges, opportunities and anything else that the entrant feels is relevant (unscored).
- 2. The entrant should demonstrate the ways in which they work with schools and/or colleges to support young people, how they do it and why.
- 3. The entrant should demonstrate clear objectives for the activities they undertake, with a defined and measurable strategy for achieving those objectives.
- 4. The entrant should demonstrate how these activities have benefited both their business, the community and young people in the borough.
- 5. The entrant should evidence what innovative methods they have used to engage with young people.
- 6. The entrant should demonstrate how their work has improved their knowledge and understanding of young people in the work place and what impact this has had on their business.

Please note:

- All questions are given equal weighting.
- All completed entry forms and evidence must be returned to events@doncaster-chamber.co.uk.
- Entrants may provide a maximum of 3 pieces of evidence to support their submission. Evidence must consist of images only i.e. charts/pictures. Entrants may be asked for additional information, including evidence of financial information, at the interview stage (Stage 2).
