



## **Success Through Partnerships**

This award recognises the combined ability of partnered organisations to seek out and develop partnerships that move beyond normal commercial relationships to deliver real added value to all partners, customers and other stakeholders.

#### Criteria

- 1. The entrant should describe their business in 400 words or less enabling judges to gain an understanding of their company, its history, customers, competitors, challenges, opportunities and anything else that the entrant feels is relevant **(unscored).**
- 2. The entrant should demonstrate clear objectives for their partnership activities together with a defined and measurable strategy for achieving those objectives.
- 3. The entrant should demonstrate how and why they formed a partnership and what differentiates it from a standard commercial relationship.
- 4. The entrant should demonstrate how they have worked together to mutually access new markets and opportunities.
- 5. The entrant should evidence how their staff work collaboratively with a particular focus on delivering excellent customer service.
- 6. The entrant should demonstrate how their partnership has contributed to their businesses' success and growth, including the business's financial performance.

#### Please note:

- All questions are given equal weighting.
- All completed entry forms and evidence must be returned to events@doncaster-chamber.co.uk.
- Entrants may provide a maximum of 3 pieces of evidence to support their submission. Evidence must consist of images only i.e. charts/pictures. Entrants may be asked for additional information, including evidence of financial information, at the interview stage (Stage 2).
