### **Agenda Topics**

#### **North Kansas City Hospital Covid-19 Report**

A written report from Dr Reintges at North Kansas City Hospital was provided to City Council members and City staff but was not shared verbally or as an attachment to the agenda.

City Administrator Eric Berlin reported that a cooperative effort between the Clay County Public Health Department and the municipalities within Clay County is being formed to have a mass vaccine location set up rather than having multiple sites within the various municipalities. A large empty building in Liberty near I-35 is being considered as a central site.

A survey has been offered online by the Health Department to determine those people who are interested in having vaccinations. A question was raised about transportation or a mobile site to address those who won't have transportation to a central site in Liberty.

#### **Gold Level Recognition for Community of All Ages Accomplishment**

The City of North Kansas City has achieved the highest level of compliance and implementation as a "Community for All Ages". North Kansas City's Bicycle Master Plan was one of the elements that earned such favorable recognition.

#### **Time Extension for 18<sup>th</sup> & Swift Development**

Because the developer is not yet ready to begin construction the agreement for use of the parking lot by the City was extended.

## Proposed Website Replacement

After an RFQ process a recommendation to utilize Granicus to develop a new website for the City was proposed and approved. Granicus is one of the largest firms specializing in digital platforms for governmental entities of all sizes. Here is a graphic that illustrates how creating documents in one location can be shared for multiple uses.



## Reinstatement of Temporary Parklet License Program

This program enabled businesses with adjacent parking spaces to their buildings to expand their service area beyond the curb into parking spaces. Approved.
