## ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Leadership Cape is an innovative community program led by the Cape Chamber, designed to identify and motivate emerging leaders and to develop their potential for community leadership roles by exposing them to opportunities, realities and challenges of our area. Individuals who have a genuine interest in leadership, who desire to increase their own levels of involvement and who wish to broaden their knowledge are encouraged to participate in Leadership Cape.

The program consists of two main types of activities: monthly learning sessions and team projects.

Completed applications are due to the Chamber office by 5:00 p.m. January 31, 2020, and applicants will be notified of acceptance by February 14, 2020.

## TUITION

Cape Chamber members: \$595  
Community members: \$645

Tuition covers supplies, meals, transportation and speakers during the seven sessions and retreat.

Tuition is due in full by March 2, 2020, and is non-refundable.

## COMMITMENT

Applicants must have the support and commitment from their business or organization and should possess the personal commitment to attend all of the program sessions. Participants are expected to attend every session and are asked to notify the program director if unable to attend a session. If more than one session is missed, the participant will need to make up the session(s) the following year to graduate.
