When you choose to invest in the Chamber of commerce, you are investing in your future and the future of the Cape Girardeau area as we continue to be the regional hub for business, education and health care.


Through Chamber membership, you can:

We work closely with [MAGNET](#) to target potential new business and industry to relocate to the region. We also work to help businesses with their workforce needs as well as business retention and expansion.




Tourism is a major economic driver! We partner with [Visit Cape](#) to bring folks to town to experience all that makes our River City special.


Influence Legislation

Part of the Chamber's service to the business community is to build relationship with local state and federal elected and full-time government officials.

To do this well, we maintain engagement with organizations such as the Missouri and U.S. Chambers, which provide important access. We also serve on statewide organizations such as the Missouri Economic Development Council and the Chamber of Commerce Executives of Missouri.



ADDED BENEFITS & RESOURCES



Mailing Labels

The Chamber makes available to its membership mailing labels with the current addresses of approximately 1,500 members. Simply call to request the labels and stop by to pick them up. The cost is \$100.



Additional Listings

Each Chamber member receives one listing in our membership directory on our website. Additional listings can be purchased for \$15. Being listed in additional categories provides additional exposure in directory searches.



Talent Attraction

Talent attraction and retention is becoming increasingly challenging for regional companies competing with larger markets across the United States. The Cape Chamber has identified the recruitment of specialized talent as a challenge locally through retention visits with major area employers, and determined a need for a talent attraction campaign - see CapelsHome.com



Meeting Room Rentals

The Cape Chamber has two meeting rooms available for rental. The board room rents for \$200 per day and seats 40-50 classroom style or 28 conference style. A smaller training room will seat up to 24 classroom or conference room style. It rents for \$100 per day. Rooms rent at half the cost for half-day rentals.
