WHEREAS: Workers took home \$23.4 billion in wages from Minnesota

manufacturing jobs in 2021, the second-largest total payroll

among private sector industries; and

WHEREAS: Manufacturing in Minnesota pays an annual average wage of

\$74,630, which is 10% higher that the state's overall average

private sector wage; and

WHEREAS: Manufacturing provides more than 310,000 highly skilled,

well-paying jobs, which significantly contribute to

Minnesota's high standard of living and economic vitality;

and

WHEREAS: Minnesota manufacturers will have more that 75,000 job

openings for production occupations through 2030 as older

workers retire.
