What the Constitution Means to Me

Is it A question? Statement? Commentary? Satire? Or Serious History?

Thankfully, while founded upon solid, Serious History, it's also quite Current and Cleverly Comical!

If it's a question: what do we think of it today? Is it still relevant? You might suggest it's a Constitutional Conundrum! One the play takes head on with some sarcasm and plenty of humor.

If it's a statement: which it is: One woman's experience and adventure with this most important U.S. document. A little-known fact, the U.S. Constitution is the 'oldest constitution' in the world."

City Theatre's Artistic Director, Margaret Ledford, explains its appeal: "the Constitution's been bandied about consistently in the press and social media these past few years creating a current controversy of politics.

However, the play takes no sides and is not a political rant." Ledford concludes, "because it's 'neutral' and funny it was the perfect play fulfilling City Theatre's mission of Contemporary Comedy."

Playwright, Heidi Schreck started her Constitutional journey as a high school student. She knew she'd have to pay her way through college and wanted to assure she could attend a great one. At the age of 15, Heidi took advantage of a debate challenge, offered by the American Legion, a Veterans Organization whose primary stated mandate is "To uphold and defend the Constitution of the United States of America. https://www. legion.org/; Touring the country, she won many of the challenges, hoarding her winnings in a 'College Fund'.

A testament to Heidi's play writing skill was the work's debut on 'Off Broadway' rapidly moving to the Helen Haves theatre on Broadway, winning many accolades and awards in the process. The Play was declared a Pulitzer Finalist in the 2019 Prize's Drama category. After a hiatus

for college and an early career teaching the English Language in Siberia, Russia, Heidi began a career as an actor and eventually playwright. She revisited her original assessments and arguments of this document, with a very 'twisted' sense of humor.

Lead Actor, Elizabeth Price, who plays Heidi in City Theatre's production this Dec. at the Adrienne Arsht Center's Carnival Theater, calls the play and her character 'Goofy Nerdy'. Indeed, at first glance, the Title, and its subject, can be accused of nerdlike tendencies! But many in the audience admit to having nerdy tendencies and enjoy a good satirical slur, accompanied by a



groaning, chuckling appreciation for the observation.

Set in a typical American Legion Hall, where the debate contests were staged, the play recreates, but also updates and modernizes our perceptions and predilections of this document.

A focus on the 14th Amendment affords the What the Constitution Means to Me" a rather 'vague' definition of 'protecting everyone', but never defines who 'everyone' is?
