- 1. Scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 will be awarded to students who express an interest in a STEM-related field. The number of scholarships to be awarded is yet to be determined. Funds will be sent directly to the post-secondary institution of the student's choice.
- 2. You will be asked which college or university you plan to attend so we can determine eligibility. Many of the scholarships will only be awarded for the student to attend the following colleges/universities: Bossier Parish Community College, Grambling State University, Louisiana State University of Shreveport, Louisiana Tech University, or Northwestern State University.
- 3. Any senior in the Bossier Parish and Caddo Parish Public School District will be eligible to apply for the 2021-22 Bossier Innovates STEM Scholarships providing they meet the eligibility requirements of a minimum GPA of 3.0, a minimum ACT of 25, and have the intention to declare a STEM-related major, particularly at the previously listed colleges or universities.
- 4. No application will be considered if all documents are not attached to the application.
- 5. No application will be accepted if it is not submitted by the deadline given on the application.

- 7. Students receiving this scholarship will be awarded on Nov. 9, 2021 at the Bossier Chamber's annual Education & Innovation Luncheon.
