EL DORADO HAS INVESTED IN THE FUTURE

Schools– USD 490 opened a new grade school in 2012, and a new middle school in 2014. In 2015 voters passed a bond issue to build two more new grade schools and a performing arts center. USD 375 voters approved construction projects, completed in 2016.

Industry– Recently, existing El Dorado businesses ConFab, White Eagle Credit Union, McDonald’s, Charley’s Appliance, Animal Care Center and OCI invested in facility expansions or new buildings. Motel 6 was established as a private brand.

Sports Complex– The BG Products Veterans’ Sports Complex opened in 2012, a joint project of the City of El Dorado, USD 490 and Butler Community College. The stadium seats 4,000 people and is home to the Butler Grizzlies and EHS Wildcats.



FIVE-YEAR PROPERTY TAX ABATEMENTS AVAILABLE

Under the City of El Dorado’s Neighborhood Revitalization Plan, new homes are eligible for a five-year tax rebate of up to \$250,000 of new appraised value on which construction begins before the end of this year.

All improvements to residential real property built before 1970 located within the City of El Dorado are eligible for the city’s NRP. Under the plan the City will offer ten-year property tax rebates for improvements executed

between January 1, 2016 and December 31, 2019. For more information about the NRP, contact the City of El Dorado Community Development Department at 316-321-9100.
