Chamber Foundation Program


YOUTH LEADERSHIP

The Youth Leadership Program is an intensive and elite, seven-month program designed to provide Eastern Shore high school students with the opportunity to gain a greater knowledge about their community, develop strong leadership skills and gain more self and social awareness. Participants engage in topic discussions including the history & geography of Baldwin County, law and government, business smarts, health and human services, and the environment. In addition to class sessions, students work in teams to develop small group projects that address and benefit a special community need.

STUDENT TRAINING AND EXPLORATION PROGRAM (STEP)

The Student Training and Exploration Program is a leadership and career pathway exploration initiative. This program engages selected students in the 9th grade and follows them through their senior year. Students explore local high-demand career opportunities while connecting classwork with skills needed in the workplace. This program also helps to instill confidence and self esteem in order for students to reach their highest potential of success. STEP works in cooperation with the Baldwin County Board of Education, local colleges, technical training facilities and local industries to connect educators to businesses on the Eastern Shore.
