



AURORA CHAMBER HOME & LIVING SHOW COVID-19 Policy

Our top priority is the health and safety of our visitors, exhibitors, sponsors, volunteers, service providers and staff. Therefore, we are implementing the following measures to ensure you have a safe experience at the show:

1. Proof of Vaccination Required

Following the Province of Ontario's announcement that it will implement a mandatory vaccination policy for indoor public events effective September 22, 2021, the Aurora Chamber Home & Living Show will require all attendees, exhibitors, sponsors, volunteers, service providers and staff to provide proof of vaccination to enter the facility (two doses plus 14 days). Effective January 4, 2022 only the use of the enhanced vaccine certificate with QR code will be accepted where proof of vaccination is required. The QR code can be used digitally or by printing a paper copy.

Effective January 10, 2022, proof of medical exemption for vaccinations is only accepted via the Provincial Vaccine Passport system. The person claiming the exemption must present their Vaccine Passport (either electronically or printed) with QR Code for scanning, along with Identification (doctor's notes are no longer accepted).

2. Covid-19 Mandatory Health Screening & Contact Tracing

All attendees, exhibitors, sponsors, volunteers, service providers and staff will be asked to complete a Covid-19 screening questionnaire before entering the premises, and provide contact information for contact tracing (this will occur each day they are on the premises).

3. Mask or Face Covering Required

It is mandatory that everyone ages 2+ wear a mask or face covering inside the Stronach Aurora Recreation Complex at all times.

4. Enhanced Cleaning Procedures

We will increase our cleaning schedule and will be disinfecting high-touch and high-traffic areas multiple times a day.

We are committed to following all official government and local authority guidelines, as well as venue-specific regulations. Due to the evolving nature of the circumstances surrounding Covid-19, we will continue to be responsive to the latest Covid-19 guidelines and will keep everyone updated on the latest developments surrounding the event.
