# **Dear Applicant:**

Applications are being accepted for the Vail Board of REALTORS® Foundation (VBRF) Academic Scholarship Award Program. Below is an overview of the scholarship program and the specific requirements. Please carefully review the scholarship guidelines and timelines for completion and submission. These must be strictly adhered to for consideration of the VBRF academic scholarship award program.

## **SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS:**

- Scholarships may be awarded in amounts up to \$2,000.00 each.
- The number of scholarships and award amounts will be based upon the VBRF budget and determined by the qualifications and number of applicants each year.

## **SECTION I: CRITERIA FOR STUDENT APPLICANTS**

- 1. Applicant must be an Eagle County resident, resided in Eagle County for at least two years and must provide proof of Eagle County residency such as a driver's license, voter's registration or another form of legal proof of residency.
- 2. Applicant must be enrolling in or returning to a college, university or accredited academic institution of higher learning in the fall of the current year as a full time student. Provide verification of the institution's statement defining a full-time student which shall include a full course load of no less than 12 hours per semester.
- 3. As an incoming freshman, the student must have graduated high school with at least a cumulative 3.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale for all four years. A returning college student must have earned a 3.0 GPA or higher the previous school year. Course selections must be at least grade appropriate or show higher academic rigor.
- 4. Applicant must disclose the cost of tuition to the institution being attended and the amount of any other scholarship monies awarded.
- 5. Scholarship winners must give the VBRF permission to use the applicant's information for marketing purposes.

#### SECTION II: SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDELINES

- 1. Failure to complete all the application requirements will result in the elimination of the entire application.
- 2. Preference is for the application to be completed in a 12-point font. Legible handwriting will be accepted as an alternative.
- 3. Submission **DEADLINE** is on or before **June 18**<sup>th</sup>.
- 4. Applications must be received at the VBR office located at 0275 Main Street, Unit G004, Edwards CO 81632 or by electronic submission to <a href="mailto:jessica@vbr.net">jessica@vbr.net</a> no later than the submission deadline date. Subject line must read: VBRF Scholarship Application.

## **SECTION III: AWARD PROCESS**

- 1. The decision to award any scholarships will be at the discretion of the VBRF Scholarship Committee. The Committee reserves the right to not award any scholarships in the event that no applications are received by the deadline, applicants fail to meet all the requirements, or do not provide all the specified information or documents.
- 2. A blind review of all applications will be performed to ensure fairness.
- 3. Scholarship winners will be announced on August 2, 2021.
- 4. The Scholarship will be provided within two weeks of receiving proof of enrollment. The Scholarship recipient must provide a photocopy of the student's college identification card and proof of current enrollment to the Vail Board of REALTORS® (VBR) office. This verification must be received by the VBR office no later than October 15<sup>th</sup>. If it is not received by such deadline, the Scholarship will be forfeited by the recipient.

3.	Copy of the <u>dated</u> letter of acceptance from the college, university or accredited
	academic institution of higher learning you will be attending OR proof of your commitment
	to return to school such as an official class schedule, confirmation of university housing
	assignment, or other official documentation from the institution - must show name of
	applicant and institution.
4.	Copy of your complete 4-year high school transcript OR, if a returning student,
	communication from the college, university or accredited academic institution of higher
	learning stating your GPA from the preceding school year.

If there is a gap in time, provide a detailed explanation as to what you did during this time <u>and</u> provide your complete 4-year high school transcript if you're a new incoming college student OR proof of your most recent academic school year GPA if you're a returning student.

6. Letter of recommendation dated and endorsed to the scholarship committee from
your academic advisor, guidance counselor, teacher, coach, college professor, advisor,
mentor or employer/internship supervisor.

made an impact on your life.
