Q & A's About Book Tickets

When does the reading or listening to books count?

*May 24, 2019

What if someone is reading to my child?

YES, ALL BOOKS READ OR LISTEN TO, COUNT!

*A group (or reading to another child) can get together and take turns reading a book aloud.

Everyone listening and reading in the group may count that as a book read.

If my child listens to an audio book, do those books count?

YES, ALL BOOKS READ OR LISTENED TO, COUNT!

Does my child only have to read/listen to age appropriate or their reading level of books?

*Those who have completed 3rd-12th grade are asked

to read 3 chapter books in 8 wks.

*Reading books during summer at your level is great but also include a large number of books below your level to help teach you to speed read.

Do magazines count?

Magazines count as 1 book.
