CLINTON CHAMBER YOUTH LEADERSHIP

What is CCYL?

CCYL is an acronym for the Clinton Chamber Youth Leadership Program. It's an exciting and progressive youth leadership program that aims to engage and challenge high school juniors and seniors to "take charge" of their lives while giving back to their community. In order to focus on these goals, only 30 students are chosen to participate each year.

Who can join CCYL and when do they meet?

To be eligible to join, applicants must be a rising junior or senior at a Clinton high school (or attend another area school and reside in Clinton) and have a minimum 2.5 GPA. Meetings are once a month from August through April, as well as participation in various community activities. CCYL participants will have fun and opportunities to be challenged.
