Pursuant to Mayoral Proclamations 2020-02,03,04, & 05, the City of Macomb and McDonough County Health Department have the following guidelines regarding outdoor seating for restaurants and bars in the City.

Social distancing, Face Coverings and other guidelines from the Center for Disease Control (CDC), Illinois Department Health (IDPH), Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO), and National Restaurant Association are to be followed.

- **Permits.** A Temporary Bar and Restaurant Outdoor Seating Permit will be required. A sketch of the proposed layout is required for the permit. Fees will be waived.
- **Timeline.** These guidelines will be temporary and effective until such time as government-imposed limits on operations and capacity of businesses brought about by the COVID-19 Pandemic are lifted.
- **ADA Requirements.** All outdoor operations will allow an accessible path 4' wide. Do not block handicapped parking spaces.
- **Life Safety.** Building entrances will not be blocked. Building standpipes and fire hydrants are to have 3' of room around them.
- **Outdoor Dining and Drinking.** No smoking and or vaping in areas designated for outdoor dining or drinking. Limit all animals to approved service animals. No outdoor buffets or self-service stations. All other food service questions can be directed to the McDonough County Health Department.
- **Litter.** Any business using an outdoor space is responsible for providing waste receptacles, ensuring the area is free of litter and cleaned.
- **Downtown:**
 - Tents. In the downtown district, the maximum tent size will be 10'x10'.
 - Upon City approval, parking spaces may be used for outdoor seating.
