Hello Chamber Members,

December is upon us, though I find hard to believe with the unseasonably warm temperatures! Soak up the last little bit of warmth, as I have no doubt the chill of December will catch us soon enough.

This month is always the busiest in the Chamber office, as we're printing out thousands of Chamber Gift Certificates to fill holiday gift orders! Did you realize we sell about \$200,000 worth of gift certificates every year? That's a lot of local



spending that we keep in the Macomb area. Our office is open through December 23, so make sure you stop by to pick up your gift certificates in time for Christmas. You are welcome to call ahead if you have a large order and we will have your certificates ready and waiting for you. You can pay with cash, check, or credit card – however there is a 4% fee if you use a credit card. We run this program as a benefit for our members and we do not make any money off it, so we are unable to absorb credit card fees.

We are finalizing the details to get Young Professionals of Macomb (YPM) up and running again in 2022 after taking a hiatus due to the pandemic. To make YPM more accessible to our area young professionals and enhance the quality of our meetings, we are seeking out sponsors to help cover the costs of the group.
