Multi-Family Community of the Year honors went to Cresleigh Homes with the HUB Apartments. Neighborhood of the Year honors went to Sutter Park by Tim Lewis Communities. Custom Home of the Year was awarded to HMA Architecture for Schaeffer's Mill Mountain Modern in Truckee.

Recognizing the changing ways of having to adapt to social distancing in new home sales efforts, virtual marketing awards were introduced. Sales professionals also reigned in many categories and over 70 awards were given to new home sales agents who sold from \$5 million to over \$15 million in sales. Rachel Newland with Taylor Morrison was awarded the Golden Achievement Sales Award for the highest sales volume.

Over 30 industry professionals or companies were also submitted by their peers or partners as Stars of the Industry.
