2020 EVCCA Report Card Summaries

+ = Alliance Supported Bills - = Alliance Opposed Bills

- + HB2494: Internal Revenue Code; Conformity (Passed Chapter 24)
 Retroactively conforms Arizona's income tax calculation for taxable years
 2016 through 2018 to include the Further Consolidated Appropriations Act.
- + HB2625: Civics Celebration Day; Civics Education (Passed Chapter 25)

Establishes September 25 as Sandra Day O'Connor Civics Celebration Day.

+ HB2686/SB1222: Building Permits; Utilities; Restrictions; Prohibitions (Passed - Chapter 3)

Prohibits a municipality or county from establishing restrictions on issuing building permits based on the utility provider that will serve that project.

+ HB2771/SB1245: Tax Credits; Qualified Facilities; Extension (Passed - Chapter 7)

Extends income tax credits for qualifying investments in qualified facilities and qualified research activity.

- + SB1021: Dept Revenue; Electronic Signatures (Passed Chapter 60)
 Allows the Arizona Department of Revenue to accept electronic signatures.
- + SB1296: Internal Revenue Code; Conformity (Passed Chapter 40)
 Conforms Arizona tax statutes to federal law for 2020.
- + SB1694/HB2911: Unemployment Compensation; Coronavirus Disease (Passed Chapter 48)

Allows for the draw down of federal dollars for COVID-19.

- + HB2106: Schools; Audits; Financial Records; Budgets Increases school budget transparency.
- + HB2108: College Course Credit; Dual Enrollment
 Requires credit for dual enrollment and stipulates that high school
 freshmen and sophomores are eligible for dual enrollment at a
 community college.
- + HB2152: Appropriation; STEM; Learning; Workforce Development Provides \$3 million for ACA grant programs for STEM learning and workforce development.

+ HB2222: CTEDs; Internships; Funding

A student enrolled in any internship course as a part of a CTED program may be included in the student count.

- + HB2380/SB1449: Product Liability; Civil Action; Limitation Allows a product liability lawsuit to commence only under defined circumstances.
- + HB2409/SB1243: Small Business Investment Credit; Extension Extends the angel investment tax credit for an additional 10 years.
- + HCR2032: Initiatives; Single Subject; Title
 Requires initiative measures to only cover one subject and matters relating to that subject.
- + HCR2039: Initiative; Referendum; Signatures; Legislative Districts
 Requires one-thirtieth of the number of signatures needed to propose
 a statewide measure or a constitutional amendment to be from each
 legislative district.
- + HCR2046: Initiatives; Referendums; Reauthorization Requires ballot measures to be reauthorized every 10 years.
- + SB1020: Ballot Measures; Proposition 105; Disclosure
 Requires a Proposition 105 notice be included on certain ballots and publicity pamphlets.
- + SB1166: Appropriation; STEM Internships
 Appropriates \$2 million for ACA grant programs for STEM learning and workforce development.
- + SB1398: Taxation; Omnibus

 Makes various changes to taxes, deduction amounts, credits and fees.
- + SB1403: CTEDs; Fourth-Year Funding Allows high school freshmen into CTEDs.
- + SCR1003: Personal Property Tax; Exemption
 Increases the personal property tax threshold to \$1 million.
