#### **WELCOME TO 2021**

Here we are in 2021. After a year of restrictions, lock downs, change of rules, social distancing and masks, we have arrived in a new year with a lot of hope in the back of our minds. Part of that hope is that we can get back to "normal" or something similar that can be labeled "new normal."

Along with this comes new codes, new building requirements and other items local jurisdictions are looking at to adopt and put in place. We, at SICBA are watching this and are asking all our members to keep watch and give Wayne a call at the office if something is being done by a jurisdiction that doesn't sound right to you or even feasible.

The City of Anacortes is going to adopt the 2018 International Codes by the end of the month because they are due in February. The proposal has been put forth to delay implementation of them due to COVID but Anacortes is going to adopt them. This is NOT the state energy code that is proposed – only the International Codes.

Along with this, the City of Anacortes Fire Department is wanting a change to the code to require sprinklers in all structures 3600 square feet and above. This does not take into consideration mitigation that should be appropriate under the current code that requires that structures more than 150 ft from a fire hydrant be required to include sprinklers or provide mitigation that will provide appropriate fire flow to the structure. While 3600 square feet is a large structure/house, this requirement will further increase the cost of housing in Anacortes. And, at one point the size was considerably lower.

SICBA is weighing in on this proposal on your behalf in an effort to keep the cost of housing as reasonable as we can. This is not only for Anacortes but for every jurisdiction in Skagit and Island Counties. So if any of you hear of something being proposed that will adversely affect housing construction through cost or any other requirement, please give us a call or a quick email. We will follow up.

# Governor Announces new Re-opening Plan, Construction Remains Open

The governor announced a <u>new "Health Washington - Roadmap to Recovery" plan</u> <u>today</u> that largely continues current COVID-19 health and safety restrictions. The plan goes into effect Jan. 11.

This new plan makes no changes to the construction industry. Construction remains open statewide and, for the foreseeable future, must continue to follow the *COVID-19 jobsite requirements* established last year.

The new "Healthy Washington" plan abandons the four-phase approach implemented last year and begins fresh with two phases at this point:

- Phase 1 continues the restrictions in place at this time, with some minor alteration; and
- Phase 2 allows restaurants, movie theaters, and other businesses with indoor activities to reopen with a cap at 25% capacity. It also allows sporting events to resume with limited capacity and increases the capacity for weddings and funerals.

The governor promised to announce additional phases in the future, but gave no timeline for when those plans will be released.



The new approach groups counties into eight regions:

- Central: King, Pierce, Snohomish
- East: Adams, Asotin, Ferry, Garfield, Lincoln, Pend Oreille, Spokane, Stevens, Whitman
- North: Island, San Juan, Skagit, Whatcom
- North Central: Chelan, Douglas, Grant, Okanogan
- Northwest: Clallam, Jefferson, Kitsap, Mason
- South Central: Benton, Columbia, Franklin, Kittitas, Walla Walla, Yakima
- Southwest: Clark, Cowlitz, Klickitat, Skamania, Wahkiakum
- West: Grays Harbor, Lewis, Pacific, Thurston

According to the governor's plan, regions may move to the next phase when they meet the following metrics, which will be determined on a weekly basis by the Washington State Department of Health::

- **Decreasing trend in** two-week rate of **COVID-19 cases** per 100K population (decrease >10%)
- Decreasing trend in two-week rate new COVID-19 hospital admission rates per 100K population (decrease >10%)
- ICU occupancy (total COVID-19 and non-COVID-19) of less than 90%
- COVID-19 test positivity rate of <10%</li>

As our state begins this new recovery plan, it is imperative that all of us in the construction industry continue to remain vigilant and proactive in following the safety requirements for your jobsites and businesses. Please continue to do your part to keep your jobsites, employees and community safe so that construction can remain open and lead the state's economy to recovery.

We will share additional information as it becomes available.

# PLEASE ALSO KNOW THAT NOTHING HAS CHANGED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY. WE ARE WORKING UNDER THE SAME GUIDELINES SET DOWN IN PHASE 2 OF THE PREVIOUS OPENING PLAN.

We have started having our meetings with the Planning and Community Development staff in Island County again. The current Planning Director is not a Planner by trade but is an administrator who is going through everything and working to make things more predictable and easier to accomplish.

There have been numerous changes in the department since COVID-19 hit and we are working to regain where we were in our process and move forward.

We have not started back in Mount Vernon as yet but once things start to open up a little more, I'm sure that group will start meeting again.

SICBA will provide you with a folder to be utilized for your entry into the Project of the Year competition. It is made up of 4 inner pages available for your use. Should you choose not to use this folder, please provide your own set up in the same manner.

On the inside cover: This page is for your application as attached.

Page 2: Glue the photographs of your project on this page. These photos may also be enclosed in document protectors and attached to the proper page if you desire.

Page 3: More photographs, plot plan, floor plan or other pertinent material.

Page 4: Your narrative of the project from start to finish. This can be more than one page and is your chance to "sell" your project.

You may send more information than what is listed above but please keep in mind that what is listed is what will be looked at the most for selection by the panel.

Do not include any information you will want returned to you. Once your entry has been received at the SICBA office, it becomes the property of SICBA and will not be returned to you. The only exception would be any additional information you might choose to provide for the competition. In this case, it will be your responsibility to pick this up after the awards are given to the winners in May.

All entries are sent to another builders association in the state for adjudication. This rotates through the other 14 associations annually and is not disclosed until after the selections are made.
