Career Pathways

Castro Valley High School's career pathways summer internship program has successfully placed 26 highly motivated students in various Engineering, Health and Biotechnical, Graphic Design, and Business internships in the Eden Area. This past spring, CVHS Engineering teacher Jessica Porter held mandatory workshops for potential interns in soft skills, resume writing, interviewing, and harassment to prepare students for their respective worksites. Students had to complete an application, be at least 16 years old, and sign a contract that made them aware of the necessary requirements of what was expected of them throughout the process. After vetting students to ensure they had the necessary maturity and preparation, many of them interviewed or were placed in sites that fit their pathway sectors.
