Castro Valley High School's career pathways programs have proven time and time again how valuable work-based learning experiences are in teaching our students how their skills relate to the world of work. Our engaged industry partners provide guest speakers, site tours, and summer internships, allowing all pathways students to better understand careers, the modern workplace, and their own professional journey. As the school year slowly winds down, our focus is primarily on setting up summer internships for motivated students in our pathways.

We are still looking for available summer internship hosts for the Health and Biotechnical (HABIT) pathway. We prepare our motivated students with a selective vetting process and a series of soft skills workshops that encompass professional skills, resume/cover letters, and interviewing for jobs. This are non-paid internships with liability insurance covered by Eden Area ROP.
