Judging Criteria:

Each entry must provide the following:

- Examples of workplace policies that set you apart and how they have benefited the business and its employees.
- Demonstrate how the employer supports its employees through training, professional development, recognition and/or job creation
- A minimum of two employee testimonials that demonstrate why your employees would agree you are the best employer

Nominations must be received no later than 5 p.m. on Monday, February 7.
