

# The Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF) is now taking applications for FY21 STIC Innovation Incentive projects.

## What is the STIC?

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) State Transportation Innovation Council (STIC) Incentive program provides resources to help foster a culture of innovation and make innovations standard practice. Through the program, funding up to \$100,000 per State per Federal fiscal year is made available to support or offset the costs of standardizing innovative practices. Incentive funding for eligible projects is for the Federal share of 80 percent, limited to \$100,000 per State each year. The full \$100,000 STIC award would require \$25,000 in matching funds.

The required 20 percent non-Federal match may come from project sponsors or other allowable fund sources. The program is administered by FHWA's Center for Accelerating Innovation. [Click HERE for more information.](#)
