AGC News & Updates

AGC of Alaska Legislative Update

The Legislature continued limited meetings last week in its first special session. The operating budget is essentially finished. The only points to negotiate between the Senate and House pertain to the Permanent Fund. As you know, the Senate voted unanimously to pass the capital budget on May 8th. The House is nearly finished hearing the bill and should vote on the capital budget in short order.

The fiscal year 2020 operating budget, not including the Permanent Fund Dividend, has more than a \$600 million surplus. The largest dividend that could be paid without "deficit spending" is around \$1,000 per eligible Alaskan.

Today, the Senate introduced SB 1002 which would fund the PFD outside of the operating budget and appropriated a little more than \$1 billion to the dividend fund. The appropriation funds include \$770,000,000 from the general fund and \$172,400,000 from the budget reserve fund. The bill (SB 1002) was referred to Senate Rules Committee, passed and returned for discussions on the Floor. That did not happen today, and the Senate adjourned around 1PM.

The Senate will reconvene tomorrow at 9:00am and the House will reconvene at 10:30am on Wednesday. It is anticipated that by the end for the week (hopefully) they will be sending the budget documents (operating and capital) to the Governor in conjunction with SB1002, with whatever amount of dividend the body eventually settles on.

As always, we will keep you posted as the week progresses. The AGC Legislative Committee meets bi-weekly during session, developing strategic advocacy on the issues at hand. Additionally, the committee holds an open work session during the fall conference, where the Association's priorities for the following year are identified.
