Your Cybersecurity Data requirements when working with the DoD

Did you know that starting in the fall of 2020, companies that do business with the DoD will need a Cybersecurity Maturity Model Certification (CMMC). [The DoD released version 1.0 which you can find here](#) or [the Public Briefing here!](#) The CMMC level of certification required for each procurement will be specified in the RFI and RFP upon release. There are 5 levels. Contractors will be required to meet the certification level at time of award. Subcontractors will also be required to obtain a CMMC requirement if they do business with the DoD. Unless a higher level is specified, all contractors and sub-contractors must meet at least a minimum CMMC Level 1. The DoD anticipate certifications through independent 3rd party assessment organizations are beginning now. 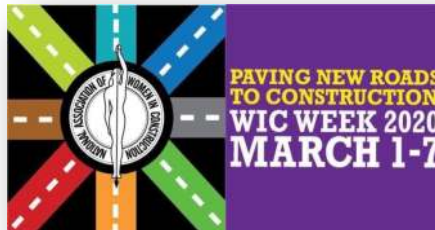

Public Workshop on Proposed DOL Regulations

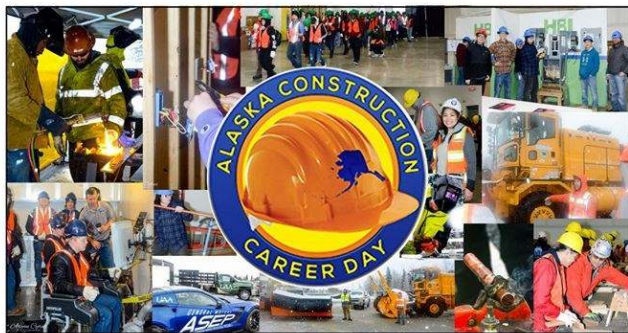
