- 1. In 2017, Yankton's population was 14,585 people. While everyone has their own opinion on the ideal city size, we think Yankton is Mama Bear in the Goldilocks story...just the right size. - 2. Yankton, affectionately referred to as the "Mother City of the Dakotas," started off as the capital of the Dakota Territory in 1861. It was a thriving river town, and the legal, political, and economic heart of the region. - 3. Did you know that Yankton has a National Park? The Missouri National Recreational River (aka: The Mighty Mo) is America's longest river and serves as a constant flow of life and beauty for our community. It runs along the southern edge of Yankton and acts as our boundary between South Dakota and Nebraska. Take a stroll on our historic double decker Meridian Bridge for the best place to experience breathtaking views of the city and our amazing river.
- 4. Lewis & Clark Lake was created in 1957 upon the completion of Gavins Point Dam, located on the Missouri River. The dammed lake is just a few miles west of the city of Yankton. It is the second-most visited South Dakota State Park, and makes residents feel like they are permanently on vacation.
- 5. The live music scene in Yankton has boomed over the past few years. Our favorite place to catch a live concert is at the Music at the Meridian events, located in a green space right along the Missouri River and at the foot of the majestic Meridian Bridge.
- 6. There are so many great outdoor recreational opportunities just waiting to be experienced here! Our top pick would be the trails near Lewis and Clark Lake, which offer a variety of options from flat, paved paths, to challenging "horse trails". All trails boast stunning views of the golden bluffs that live along the shores of the Missouri River.
- 7. From tuition-free preschool through a higher education degree, quality education is valued and supported in Yankton. Learn about the variety of options available to you on page 26!


#### LABEL EVERY BOX. DON'T GET LAZY!








#### A SAFE COMMUNITY

# **MERIDIAN BRIDGE**

The Meridian Bridge, built in 1924 by the motivated citizens of Yankton, is a historic and iconic bridge constructed originally for vehicle and rail traffic, complete with a lift mechanism for steam boat traffic on the Missouri River. The bridge has since been retired for vehicular traffic but is now one of a handful of double decker bridges in existence, and is the longest pedestrian bridge to span two states. The views of the Missouri River and downtown Yankton are breathtaking from this platform, and many residents make walking, running, or biking it part of their daily exercise routine. www.cityofyankton.org


#### **HUNT AND FISH WITH US**




