## ECONOMIC INJURY DISASTER LOANS

Available to South Dakota Small Businesses

Small nonfarm businesses in 32 South Dakota counties and neighboring counties in Iowa, Minnesota and Nebraska are now eligible to apply for low-interest federal disaster loans from the U.S. Small Business Administration, announced Director Tanya N. Garfield of SBA's Disaster Field Operations Center-West. These loans offset economic losses because of reduced revenues caused by drought in the following primary counties that began July 6, 2021.

The deadline to apply for economic injury is March 14, 2022.

Applicants may apply online, receive additional disaster assistance information and download applications at <u>disasterloanassistance.sba.gov</u>. Applicants may also call SBA's Customer Service Center at (800) 659–2955 or email <u>disastercustomerservice@sba.gov</u> for more information on SBA disaster assistance. 




