COVID-19 UPDATES

Ohioans eligible to get the COVID-19 vaccine:

- ✓ Age 65+
- Those with severe congenital or developmental disorders and medical conditions listed in the Priority Populations Fact Sheet.
- Employees of K-12 schools that wish to remain or return to in-person or hybrid models.
- Feb. 15 Ohioans born with or who have early childhood conditions that are carried into adulthood, which put them at a higher risk for adverse outcomes due to COVID-19, may choose to receive the vaccine at the provider of their choice, but will be asked by their vaccine provider to confirm that they are, in fact, eligible at this time.
