#### **Application Instructions**

IMPORTANT NOTE: Read and follow all instructions carefully. Applications that do not comply with these instructions may be disqualified. All applications must be typed or legibly handwritten and completed in full.

### **Completing the Application**

**Complete the auto-fill application (below in this document).** Save this application to your computer, complete the auto-fill application, save and print. OR, you may print out the application and complete in legible handwriting. Submit the completed application and required documentation <u>in one envelope</u> to:

The application and the required documents must be submitted together <u>in one envelope</u>, or the application may be ineligible for consideration. Application package must be RECEIVED in the Foundation's office by the deadline. Applications received after the deadline may not be considered.

#### **Eligibility Requirements**

- 1. Applicant must have been accepted or is enrolled for the fall semester as a student in a Texas technical/trade school or community college/university and must be pursuing a residential construction related trade certification or residential construction degree.
- 2. If applicant is a high school senior, they must have attended high school in Texas.

## **Selection Criteria**

Applicants are evaluated using the following criteria:

- Career goals
- Financial need
- Academic achievement
- Employment history
- Extracurricular activities

## Award Information

- 1. Individual scholarships will be awarded for the upcoming fall semester.
- 2. The application **RECEIPT** deadline is April 19, 2024
- 3. Awards will be announced by May 31, 2024.
- 4. Applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee and recommendations will be made to the Board of Trustees of the Texas Builders Foundation.
- 5. The Board of Trustees of the Texas Builders Foundation may request interviews with the applicants who are finalists for the scholarship awards.
- 6. Scholarships are distributed through the Texas Builders Foundation, and checks are made payable to and mailed directly to the school in which the student has been accepted or is enrolled for the fall semester.
- 7. Students may apply for additional scholarships during the application cycle before their current award will expire. The award of an initial scholarship does not guarantee the award of an additional scholarship to the student.
- 8. Second/subsequent semester awards are contingent upon the student maintaining enrollment and good academic standing.
- 9. All selection decisions are final and are not subject to appeal.
- 10. Applications and supporting documents become the sole property of the Texas Builders Foundation and will not be returned.

## Application

- 1. Signature of applicant is required on page 7.
- 2. Application may be typed or legibly handwritten.
- 3. Answer all questions. Confine your responses to the space provided. Do not submit additional materials unless instructed. Extra pages or materials such as resumes, certificates or newspaper clippings will not be read or considered in the award process.
- 4. The Financial Information section is an important part of your application. Answer all questions; incomplete information may lower your score. If you are not sure how to answer a question, call the Texas Builders Foundation at (512) 476-6346 for assistance.
- 5. If using the auto-fill feature, save the application to your computer, complete the auto-fill application, save, and print single sided. Do not staple, bind or paper clip your application materials.

## Transcript Requirements

1. An official transcript from your current school is required.
