#### Lastly.... We have a new Executive Director!

We would like to welcome Jeff Williams to the SACC as our new Executive Director. Jeff grew up in the Ann Arbor area and graduated from Huron High School in 1978. He went to the University of Michigan and graduated in 1982 with a BA in English Lit and Political Science. He is also a graduate from Eastern Michigan University with a Master of Public Administration degree. He has also completed executive education work at Harvard Business School and the University of Oxford's Saïd Business School, and Cornell University.

Jeff began his 35-year career first as a Financial Analyst in 1986 with University Microfilms (now ProQuest). He then worked as a Senior Financial Analyst for the Michigan Medical system until 1993 when, soon after completing his master's degree, he joined a software firm in Knoxville, Tennessee, as Manager of Financial Analysis to prepare them for an initial public offering.

After the successful IPO in 1995, a promotion to Corporate Controller, and a merger with Emerson Electric in 1998, Jeff returned to Michigan and founded an award-winning publishing company; where for seven years he authored, marketed, and published family history books that were sold in 42 states and four countries, and which in 2004 won a State of North Carolina award for best family history book.



Jeff then returned to the financial arena in the non-profit sector. In 2005 he became the Finance Director for YCUA (the Ypsilanti Community Utilities Authority). In 2008 he entered the higher education sector as Chief Financial Officer of Concordia University in Ann Arbor. For the past 13 years Jeff has been a CFO to universities on the east coast and the Midwest; as well as a K-12 start up in Hanoi Vietnam. His most recent role, ending this month, was as the interim CFO for Muskegon Community College.

Jeff has been active in volunteer work as financial peer-review accreditation team member for universities in the Midwest, east coast, Puerto Rico and Texas for the Middle States Commission on Higher Education, and the Association of Theological Seminaries. He has served as a Scholarship Committee Member for American Mensa, and as an Audit Committee member for the United Way of Washtenaw County; and as a Member/Past Chairman of the Canton Township Leisure Services Advisory Committee. Jeff is a Life Member of the National Eagle Scout Association and Life Member of the University of Michigan Alumni Association.
