The LCMS experience is about so much more than a private lesson.

The school is recognized nationally and internationally for its comprehensive and innovative programming for students of all ages and levels, from babies through to seniors, at beginner to pre-professional levels. Many of our alumni have gone on to successful careers as professional musicians. Importantly, the many thousands of students who have been through our doors since 1969 have experienced the joy of music making, taking with them the benefits of a music education that last a lifetime.

LCMS is also a presenter of concerts



in our Rose Gellert Hall, a 250-seat performance space that has become an important cultural hub for Langley and surrounding communities. Our two concert series, which take place on Saturday evenings and Sunday afternoons, present local, national and international artists, as well as feature young emerging artists. The concerts include the classics, jazz and contemporary works, and bring an exceptional caliber of musical artistry to the community.

Governed by a community-minded board, LCMS strives to ensure that a high quality music education is accessible to all. The school is proud to be able to fulfill its charitable purpose as a result of the donations and sponsorships we receive. We have a strong scholarship and bursary program, and low-cost or free outreach programs for children and youth in our community.

Our students and faculty share music with the community through free performances at seniors' residences, local schools, and civic events. Our sincere thanks to the many individuals, businesses and organizations that have supported LCMS over the years.

Throughout 2019, we are proud to be presenting artists in our concert series with a special connection to LCMS, including a number of our alumni.
