BY CAR:

Bethel is located prominently at the intersection of U.S. Route 2 and state routes 26 and 5

From the **south**, follow I-95 north to Exit 63 in Gray, ME, then Rt. 26 north approximately 50 miles to Bethel. From the west, Bethel is located on Route 2 approximately 12 miles east of the Maine/New Hampshire border.

BY AIR:

Commercial flights are available to Portland, Maine (PWM; 90 minute drive), Manchester, NH (MHT; 2.5 hour drive), or Boston, MA (BOS; 3.5 hour drive or bus & train service will get you as far as Portland). From Portland, car rental or private shuttle service is available.

The Bethel Regional Airport offers a 3,818' runway where visual flight rules apply. Tie-downs, hangar storage, and self-serve fuel are available. FMI: (207) 512-5552, bethelregionalairport.com.

Bethel is the definition of an authentic New England town. The town has been cultivated over more than 200 years' time, but it's not at all stuck in the past. It is the service center for several surrounding towns – when you visit, you may end up passing through or staying in Newry, Greenwood, Woodstock, Hanover, Gilead, Andover, or beyond. Together these small towns comprise a community that is an enchanting mix of modern amenities and historic roots. Bethel's walkable village charms with its tidy, locally-owned shops and gracious homes. Winding roads fan out into the river valleys and the surrounding farmland and mountains.

The people and the land are intertwined in all aspects of their lives, work, and recreation, creating a lifestyle that keeps long-time locals wondering why they would live anywhere else and continues to draw in the new. Bethel's economy has always been a blend of farming and wood products and tourism, with changing times affecting the balance. Bethel has also long been an educational, cultural, and healing center. Ever since Dr. Gehring's famous clinic for treatment of city people with "nervous disorders" in the very early 1900s, people have been coming here to reinvigorate themselves with fresh air, clean water, and getting outside.

Want to know more? Stop at the chamber of commerce Visitors' Center for current information, or visit the Museums of the Bethel Historical Society at its two buildings in the Broad Street Historic District and ask for the self-guided walking tour of gracious older buildings in the village, or speak with its knowledgeable staff.

SOUTHWEST: WINDING ROADS THROUGH WHITE MOUNTAIN NATIONAL FOREST TO FRYEBURG

- Total: 77 miles, drive time 1 hr. 48 mins
- Route 2 West to Gilead 10 miles
- Left on Route 113 to Fryeburg 29 miles
- Left on Route 5 to Bethel 36 miles

Route 113, a National Scenic Byway, is the twistiest-turniest road around, traveling through Evans Notch on the eastern edge of the White Mountains. Cruising along the Wild River under a canopy of trees is enchanting. In spots, the views open up to the White Mountains beyond as you continue through old farmsteads and into Stow and on to Fryeburg. Several roadside pull-outs offer views and hiking trailheads with trails for all abilities. As you return on Route 5, you'll pass by beautiful lakes and the charming villages of Lovell and Waterford.

NORTHWEST: BIG MOUNTAIN VIEWS & COVERED BRIDGE

- Total: 65 miles, drive time 1 hr. 42 mins
- Route 2 East to Newry 6 miles
- Left on Route 26 to Upton 28 miles
- Right on Andover Road/East B Hill Road to Andover 14 miles
- Right on Route 5 to Rumford Point 11 miles
- Right on Route 2 to Bethel 12 miles

Grafton Notch State Park is an absolute must-do when visiting the Bethel area. Pack a picnic for Screw Auger Falls, a stunning waterfall. Perhaps leave time for a short hike up to Table Rock, or the Eyebrow, both viewpoints on the Appalachian Trail. There's a great chance you may see some wildlife. A right turn on the Andover Road/East B Hill Road delivers you to the bucolic village of Andover. Pastures dot the landscape as you travel back south along Route 5. Keep your eye out for the Lovejoy covered bridge over the Ellis River for a perfect photo op. Travel back toward Bethel along the Androscoggin River.

Road Trip

WILDLIFE-VIEWING & LAKE COUNTRY LOOP

- Total: 146 miles, drive time 3 hrs 15 mins
- Route 2 East to Newry 6 miles
- Left on Route 26 to Errol, NH 31 miles
- Right on Route 16 to Oquossoc, ME 35 miles
- Left on Route 4 to Rangeley 7 miles
- Return to Oquossoc on Route 4 7 miles
- Left on Route 17 to Mexico 35 miles
- Right on Route 2 to Bethel 24 miles

Make a day of this route if you can. Viewing potential is high for moose, deer, eagles, and more. After leaving Bethel, pass through Grafton Notch State Park with its stunning views and several natural roadside attractions. Approaching the villages of Oquossoc and Rangeley, mountains get taller and the lakes are huge. Hit Rangeley for lunch, shopping, and sight-seeing, then return to Oquossoc where you'll turn south on Route 17. This National Scenic Byway leads to a famous overlook known as the Height of Land, the highest point on the road, commanding views of the mountains and lakes to the west. Route 17 continues south past a stunning gorge and waterfall at Coos Canyon, then along the Swift River to the towns of Mexico and Rumford, where you will connect with Route 2 west along the Androscoggin River back to Bethel.

Choose the Bethel area as your wedding destination and your guests will be talking about your big day for years to come. Couples will appreciate the wow-factor of the mountain scenery, with a wide variety of facilities available to make

your day perfect and unique. Guests will love that their trip to Bethel can double as a mini-vacation, with loads of ways to explore the area and lodging for all tastes and budgets.

Your options include village inns, stunning mountain vacation homes, grand ballrooms, and classic farmhouses and barns. All the services you need are available locally – venues, caterers, florists, tent and supply rentals, officiants, spas, and salons – and they're staffed with friendly, helpful folks who want to

make your wedding just right.

PADDLING

With boat launches accessible every few miles, the Androscoggin River allows you to choose whether to be out for a couple hours or all day long. Canoe and kayak rentals are readily available from **Pleasant River Campground** or **Bethel Outdoor Adventure**, which also rents tubes and stand-up paddleboards.

Sport Thoma Maine will deliver your preferred paddle-powered boat to your water body of choice – a great option if you've got a waterfront vacation rental.

Prefer flatwater? **The Local Hub** in Greenwood is known for its tasty homemade grub, but it also rents kayaks that you can launch into the network of ponds right behind the store.

Need instruction? Hire a guide (pg 53-54), or take a lesson with **Sunday River's** L.L. Bean Discovery School.

WHITEWATER RAFTING

Head north to Errol, NH for more paddling options and whitewater rafting with ELC Outdoors or Northern Waters Outfitters. Three classic New England rivers adjacent to the Umbagog National Wildlife Refuge within an hour's drive of Bethel are home to whitewater ranging from mild to wild. Closest to Bethel is the Androscoggin River - as it emerges from Lake Umbagog, it offers an excellent introduction to rafting for first-timers or families. The Magalloway River is a great choice for groups looking for a little more excitement, with myriad twists and turns and near Class III/IV rapids. The Rapid River is a steep, remote, class IV river that connects lower Richardson Lake to Lake Umbagog. Nestled deep in the Maine wilderness, it sees little traffic, making for a unique experience.

MOTOR BOATS

A trip to **Kezar Lake Marina** to rent a motor boat and possibly some waterskiing gear would be a wonderful way to experience this gorgeous body of water.

Sunday River Resort offers an entire mountain range of possibilities across its eight interconnected peaks and 135 trails, including 870 acres of terrain ranging from outstanding beginner facilities, immaculately groomed intermediate slopes, steeps and glades for experts, and a range of terrain parks. On-mountain lodging and dining options abound and the fun goes from morning until night, on-slope and off, thanks to night skiing, tubing, concerts, and so much more. Truly legendary snowmaking and grooming create a snow surface that's unmatched in the east in quality and longevity. It's also home to **Maine Adaptive Sports & Recreation**, which offers free skiing and other year-round programming to individuals with physical disabilities. sundayriver.com

Mt. Abram Ski Area is a family-friendly, community-minded ski area with excellent terrain just five miles from Bethel village. It offers 51 trails for all ability levels across 550 acres and a boundary-to-boundary ski policy. Mt. Abram prides itself on its environmental sustainability efforts, including producing power with one of the largest solar arrays in Maine. For more than 55 years, Mt. Abram has been one of Maine's premiere learn-to-ski areas. Westside Area is the hub for families, with a base lodge, a heated pavilion, a chairlift, and magic carpet. Lessons are designed to ease new skiers and riders into the sport the fun way. The Main Lodge is home to an après scene - cruise into Loose Boots Lounge for live music, wine tasting, great beer, and tasty food. Open Thursdays – Sundays and every day during Maine school vacation weeks. mtabram.com





ZIPLINES AND OTHER HIGH FLYING ADVENTURES

Try exploring the forest from a new angle – high up in the treetops on a zipline. Sunday River's twin zips offer a quick trip, or get the full experience with a two-hour, multi-zip tour through the woods and over ravines. Sunday River also offers a bungee trampoline, climbing wall, and chairlift rides. ELC Outdoors offers Aerial Adventures with zip lines, a climbing tower, and ropes course.

WILDLIFE VIEWING

Maine and nearby New Hampshire are the two most forested states in the country, crisscrossed by rivers and lakes. Moose, deer, bear, eagles, osprey, loons, ducks, and other creatures great and small call it home. Take a drive (pg 16), a hike (pg 28), a paddle (pg 20), or even a pontoon boat ride on Lake Umbagog, and don't forget your camera and binoculars.

FISHING AND HUNTING

Work with a guide who can set you up with all the gear and expertise you need to catch an impressive brook trout or bass, or help you navigate the hunt of a lifetime.

MAGGIE RING'S NATURE PARK

Getting There: The parking lot and two trailheads for Maggie's Nature Park are on the Greenwood Road on the west side of South Pond in the Town of Greenwood. From Bethel, take Howe Hill Road off of Route 26. Go over railroad tracks and turn left onto Greenwood Road. Continue for 1.4 miles and turn right at the sign into the parking lot.

What to Expect: Maggie Ring's Nature Park is laid out in a well-marked network of loops. Check the map at the trailhead before setting off. The trails are mostly quite gentle – great for beginners, kids, dogs, or just getting out for an hour or two of fresh air. The most scenic spot of the park is Peaked Mountain Bluff with views overlooking Twitchell Pond. Additional views include North and South Ponds along the Ledge Trail and Mount Abram after a moderate climb on the Loop Trail.

0.75 to 3.2 miles, 1.5-2 hours, depending on route

MOUNT WILL

Getting There: Take US Route 2 east from Bethel Village heading towards Rumford. About 1.9 miles past the state Riverside Rest Area on the right and Sunday River Brewing Company on the left, there is a parking area on the left directly opposite the Bethel Recycling and Transfer Station.

What to Expect: This popular summer hike or winter showshoe is a complete loop, but often hikers choose a shorter trip to either the North Ledges for views up the Androscoggin Valley, or South Cliffs, with views back towards Bethel village.

1-2 miles, 1 hour

BUCK'S LEDGE & LAPHAM LEDGE

From Bethel village, go south on Route 26. From the intersection of Howe Hill Road in the Locke Mills village of Greenwood, continue for 2.1 miles to a small parking lot on the left at the top of a rise.

These trails start together on a gravel road. At 0.5 miles, the trail to Lapham Ledge leaves the road and goes to the right at a sign. The Lapham Ledge trail continues another 0.5 miles to the Ledges where there are mountain and pond views to the south and east. New in 2017: Lapham Ledge was expanded into a loop.

To reach Buck's Ledge, go past the Lapham Ledge trail and continue hiking on the road for another 0.5 miles, where the trail to Buck's Ledge breaks away from the road on the left. Continue 0.6 miles to the top of a long ledge to enjoy views of North and South Ponds, Mount Abram, and the Mahoosuc and White Mountains in the distance.



Hiking in the Bethel area

No matter the season, no matter the level of challenge, you'll discover a hike to love near Bethel. Trails range in difficulty from a paved pathway along the Androscoggin River, all the way on up to the most challenging mile of the Appalachian Trail. It's an easy drive to the White Mountain National Forest to the west, Grafton Notch State Park to the north, and many other trails on other public and conserved lands.

Respect trails and the landowners who allow trails on their property

In Maine, trails of all kinds are likely to cross a patchwork of public and/ or privately-owned lands. Future access depends on their users' respect of the trails and surrounding land. Stay on the trails, carry out whatever you carry in, and never damage what you find.

ON THE ROAD

Enjoy the scenery at a slower pace. Try these easy-to-moderate difficulty loops.

EASY – VERNON STREET & ROUTE 5/35

15 miles, relatively flat

Highlight: Scenic Songo Pond

Starting on Main Street in the village of Bethel, turn onto Vernon Street. After 7 miles, take a right onto Route 5/35 back towards Bethel. Be careful on this stretch as it can be busy and has little to no shoulder. After 6 miles, take a right on Mill Hill Road (a short, steep climb) past The Bethel Inn Resort to get back to Main Street and the village.

MEDIUM – NORTH ROAD & ROUTE 2

21 miles, some small to moderate hills

Highlight: Dramatic views along Androscoggin River valley

Park at the lot on Route 2/26 adjacent to the Bethel Pathway (next to a Shell station/Dunkin' Donuts). Cross the Androscoggin River and take an immediate left on North Road. After 10 miles, take a left on Bridge Street and cross the Androscoggin again. Take a left on Route 2 east and return to Bethel usually with a prevailing tailwind!

ON THE TRAILS

BETHEL RECREATIONAL PATHWAY

The Bethel Recreational Pathway is a super-easy, all-ages friendly, paved path along the Androscoggin River where you'll find people walking, jogging, and biking. Park at Davis Park (also home to a playground and skate park) at the east end of Parkway Road at the intersection of Route 26.

MOUNTAIN BIKING

Amethyst, aquamarine, and tourmaline in many colors, including the renowned pink-and-green "watermelon" variety, are some of the gems that are found in this special place. For a perfect souvenir, seek out locally-mined and -designed jewelry, or a special find from a gem sluice.

The Maine Mineral and Gem Museum is dedicated to collecting, and researching the world's largest display of outstanding Maine minerals and gems. MMGM's major exhibits are still under construction, but it has already become a hub of extensive archives documenting the cultural and natural history of mining in Maine - and, as an added bonus, features some of the most important specimens of space rocks (from the moon, Mars, and meteorites) outside of NASA's own collections.

For a hands-on family adventure, discover your own gems by digging through buckets of material from area mines provided by sluices at Maine Mineralogy Expeditions at Bethel Outdoor Adventure or Maine Mineral Adventures. You never know what you might find.






